Must Register by 8/1/2015 at 12:00 noon at the Town Hall front steps.

Rules-

- ⇒ The 'bed' must have wheels (no specific number of wheels) (Rental beds are available—see above)
- ⇒ The 'bed' must have 2 sheets and a pillow with pillow case
- \Rightarrow The 'bed' must have a teddy bear
- ⇒ 5 person team one on/in bed to shoot baskets and four pushing

Race Course-

- 1) Start Line Wait for the air horn to go
- 2) Race to the basketball hoop 5 Chances to Score
- 3) Race to the "Jug Filling" with the Bedpan
- 4) Fill the jug wait for the signal to go from judge
- 5) Race to the finish line
